

Specs for Video Upload

Maximum file size: **100MB per file**

16:9 aspect ratio - If the original content was formatted 4:3, please provide curtains (black bars on each side) which are most typically referred to as “pillar box” to accommodate appropriately for 16:9 playback.

QuickTime (.mov) file format specs that should be easily applied within your non-linear editing tool such as Final Cut Pro, Adobe Premiere or QuickTime Pro are:
